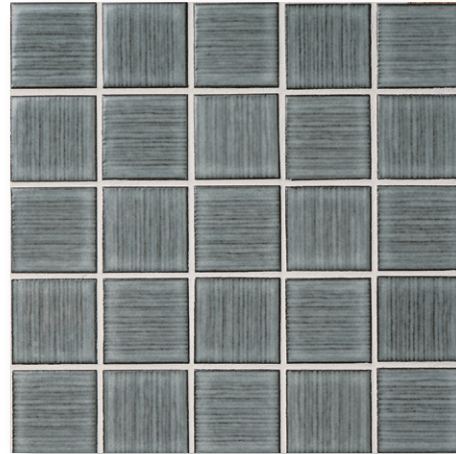

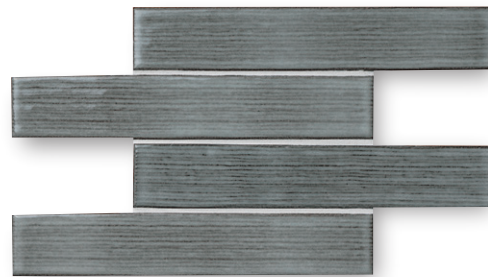

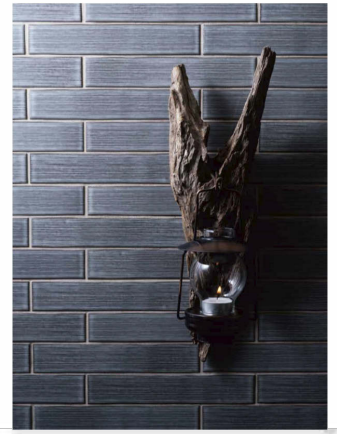
**Note** Wide shade variation inherent in this series.

If cuts are required, pieces should be removed from the mesh and cut individually to avoid the glue releasing from the mesh, prior to completion of installation. The sheets should also NOT be exposed to moisture prior to installation.

### RECOMMENDED AREAS OF USE

With regard to the durability of the bisque and glaze, this material is suitable for:

- All countertop applications - residential and commercial
- Fireplace surround, hearth and firebox
- Light commercial flooring applications and all residential flooring applications
- All interior wall applications - residential and commercial
- All exterior wall applications - residential and commercial including building facades, swimming pools, fountains, outdoor kitchens and regions that experience extreme weather conditions, subject to the method of installation

### INSTALLATION METHOD

- Always inspect material prior to installation, for color, shade, size, mounting and any other deciding factors as installed material cannot be accepted for return or credit. Use signifies acceptance.
- Please note that mesh mounted goods should never be placed directly on the wet saw for cutting. If cuts are required, pieces should be removed from the mesh and cut individually to avoid the glue releasing from the mesh.
- Material can be cleaned with any mild nonabrasive household cleaning product due to the chemical resistant nature of the glaze.
